



KENYA TOURIST VISA/BUSINESS VISA INFORMATION SHEET

Requirement	Description
Filing Applications	Applications for tourist and business visa applications can be filed at a Kenyan High Commission in the following locations: · Pretoria If your current location does not have a Kenyan Embassy or High commission nearby for filing the application, please contact us for more information.
Visa Exemptions	The following nationalities are visa-exempt for tourist and business purposes in Kenya: Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Botswana, Brunei, Burundi, Cyprus, Dominica, Eswatini, Ethiopia, Fiji, Grenada, Gambia, Ghana, Jamaica, Kiribati, Lesotho, Malawi, Malaysia, Maldives, Mauritius, Namibia, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Rwanda ID, Samoa, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, San Marino, Seychelles, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Africa, Tanzania, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Tuvalu, Uganda, Vanuatu, Zambia, Zimbabwe.
Passport	A valid passport with at least 6 months validity from the date of return from the scheduled trip with at least 3 blank pages at date of submission. A certified copy of passport bio-data page.
ID	A certified copy of your ID document.
Application Form	A completed application form signed by the applicant.
Passport Photos	Two (2) recent colour passport photographs with a white background. Passport photos must show all facial features clearly and no earrings or head accessories allowable.
Flight Itinerary	A copy of a flight itinerary with a return flight to/from Kenya.
Proof of financial means	Evidence of sufficient funds to cover entire stay in Kenya.
Yellow Fever Certificate	A certified copy of a yellow fever certificate.
Accommodation	Proof of accommodation such as a hotel booking.
Letter of Invitation	For business applications only, a letter of invitation from a Kenyan company indicating the nature of your business activities in Kenya, passport details, and expected duration of stay as well as accepting full immigration responsibility for your stay in Kenya. A copy of the ID document of the Kenyan company's signatory must be included.
Employer Letter	For business applications only, a letter from your current employer indicating the nature of your business activities in Kenya and assuming responsibility for any financial, medical, and accommodation expenses.
Processing times	4 – 5 working days.
